3. Carriers bidding to a CC Grade 2 position must begin a new waiting period for their next step increase. Those bidding from steps A, B, and C are subject to the promotion pay anomaly, which results in the payment of so-called 'ABC' lump-sum payments offset any wage losses that would otherwise occur due to the anomaly. However, they do not compensate carriers for reduced Thrift Savings Plan contributions, earnings and tax savings. The timing of ABC promotions can greatly affect total earnings—carriers should exercise great caution when bidding to carrier-technician positions.
