Carriers collect 70.6 million pounds of food

The 23rd annual Letter Carriers' "Stamp Out Hunger" Food Drive has come and gone, and this year's collection figures are once again impressive.

On Saturday, May 9, active and retired NALC members, alongside family members, friends and other volunteers, collected—in the form of canned and boxed non-perishable food as well as monetary donations—the equivalent of more than 70.6 million pounds donated by generous postal customers.

"Everyone involved in this year's food drive should be proud of this terrific result," NALC President Fredric Rolando said. "Your generous donation of time and energy will help ensure that millions of our customers—children and adults—can put desperately needed food on their tables."

The official national tally, announced on June 15, showed that the more than 1,300 NALC branches participating this year had worked together to deliver to community food banks, pantries and shelters 64,572, 665 pounds of actual food, plus another \$1,668,799.13 in monetary donations. By a formula provided by national food drive sponsor Feeding America, \$1 can buy 3.6 pounds, so a bit of simple math turns \$1.6 million in cash into 6,007,677 pounds, for a grand total of 70,580,342 pounds of food collected this year.

Taking top honors for food collections among all NALC branches was Central Florida Branch 1091, collecting 1,725,772 pounds of food. West Coast Florida Branch 1477 came in second with 1,460,280 pounds, followed by Clearwater, FL Branch 2008 with 1,275,289 pounds. The top money collector was Oklahoma City, OK Branch 458, which recognized donations of \$851,452.48—a sum that converts to 3,065,229 pounds of food.

Held as always on the second Saturday in May, this year's food drive was made possible by participation of numerous letter carriers and customers in more than 10,000 cities and towns representing all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and Guam.

President Rolando praised the countless thousands of city letter carriers who were ably assisted by postal employees from the other crafts alongside untold numbers of volunteers to collect, sort and deliver the donations.

"This year's achievement demonstrates the power of solidarity, the generosity of our customers and the determination of letter carriers to help those in need," he said. "It's solid proof of what has been said many times before: that our commit-

ment to our communities doesn't end at the mailbox."

Working together

City letter carriers—full-time and part-time alike—were helped in many communities by their brothers and sisters in the National Rural Letter Carriers' Association, a national sponsor of this year's drive. The other national sponsors offered equally invaluable support in a variety of ways: the U.S. Postal Service, United Way Worldwide, the AFL-CIO, Valpak and Vallassis—not to mention Feeding America and its network of food bank affiliates.

"The letter carriers are one of our oldest partners in hunger relief," Feeding America West Michigan's Ken Estelle told *The Grand Rapids Business Journal*. "Year after year, they give their time and money to organize this enormous effort—our biggest food drive of the year."

In fact, the food drive is the largest one-day food collection event in America. After a successful pilot drive was held in 10 cities in October of 1991, work began almost immediately on making it a nationwide effort.

On May 15, 1993—the second Saturday

in May—NALC held its first national drive with a goal of having at least one branch in each of the 50 states taking part. It just so happened that more than 220 branches wound up signing on, collecting more than 11 million pounds of food—which was then a one-day record in the United States.

“It’s just a big responsibility in giving back to the community,” Columbia, SC Branch 233 letter carrier Sedrick Thurman told WLTX-TV on this year’s Food Drive Day. The station noted that, after Thurman finished delivering his route, the letter carrier’s LLV was full. “Every five to six houses, I had to stop and throw the food bags in the back,” he said.

Scot Garrick with Columbia’s Harvest Hope Food Bank told WLTX-TV that the food drive’s timing works well for meeting food banks’ needs.

“When summer’s here, at-risk children are deprived of the meals that they would normally get at school,” Garrick said. “For these kids, summer is not a time of vacation—there is no vacation for hunger.”

There’s a typical outpouring of donations to food banks during the winter holiday season, but “it slows down pretty drastically after the first of the year,” Lori Botkin, executive director of Kalispell, MT’s Flathead Food Bank, told KFBB-TV. “With summer coming and everybody out doing all the fun stuff, there’s still a lot of people hungry in our community who

don’t get to do the fun stuff and sometimes even go to bed hungry at night.

“It’s really important that we don’t forget about those people year-round,” Botkin said.

“This is a critical time of year for us,” Second Harvest’s Mike Kantor told New Orleans’ WWL-TV. “Folks who are struggling throughout the year struggle even more during the summer.”

Tina Dunn, food drive coordinator for Eau Claire, WI Branch 728, explained to WEAU-TV why letter carriers take this on, year after year.

“You’re making a difference for someone as close as your neighbor,” Dunn said. “It’s for the disabled, for the elderly, for the person who just lost their job and still needs to feed their children. It’s for the people out there that have to choose between making their rent payment or putting food on the table.”

And letter carriers try their best to make sure that none of these folks are forgotten.

“The food drive is just a wonderful thing,” Fairmont, WV Branch 910 food drive coordinator Tjuana Bassett told WBOY-TV. “Even coming out and volunteering, they are able to see what people do to help them, so just being able to help someone is just great.”

Ben DeFeo of Jefferson City, MO’s Samaritan Center agreed. “The community really gets behind it,” he told KRCG-TV. “They put all their canned goods out on their mailboxes, the letter carriers and other volunteers go around and pick it up, it gets sorted out here and we get a portion of it for our food pantry.”

Reno, NV Branch 709’s Kenny Groves told KRNVTV that he looks forward to





the food drive every year. “The pounds of food that we’ve gotten over the years is just amazing,” he said. “Our minds have been blown almost every year. This community is very generous.”

Still needed

Sadly, the need remains very real in just about every corner of America. For example, Mark Johnson, a spokesman for Volunteers of America Western Washington, told Everett, WA’s *The Herald* that last year’s food drive brought in half of all donated food to local food banks there in 2014.

“More than 50 percent of our clients are families with children,” Johnson said, adding that more than 48,000 people were set to visit a food bank in his local county during the month of May alone.

In its 2014 “Hunger in America” report, Feeding America found that one in seven Americans turns to the food banks and feeding programs in its network for food assistance.

These facilities provide some measure of food assistance to 46.5 million people, including 12 million children and 7 million seniors.

“Client households often survive on limited budgets and are confronted with choices between paying for food and paying for other essentials,” the report said.

Feeding America also found that one in five of the households served by its network has at least one member who has ever served in the military, and approximately 620,000 of these households have at least one member who is currently serving in the U.S. military on active duty, in the reserves or in the National Guard.

Personal reasons

Knoxville, TN resident Connie Duncan told WVLT-TV that she appreciates how all food donations stay local. “I like

to help out the local community,” she said. “That’s where we live, and that’s where we see the poor and hungry.”

The fact that so many of the hungry are children breaks the heart of Knoxville Branch 419 letter carrier (and mother) Samantha Summers. “I’m glad that I can help other moms,” she told WVLT.

There are probably as many personal reasons to participate in the Food Drive in some capacity as there are letter carriers, customers and volunteers. For example, Tony Minerva, a food drive volunteer in Central Islip, NY, told Long Island’s *Fios 1 News* that he knows firsthand what it means to go without food.

“My father was a bus driver, and they had been on strike for an extended period of time” when he was 7 or 8 years old, Minerva said. “The union actually brought to the house boxes of food,” he said. “They brought us a turkey, they brought us a Thanksgiving dinner.

“That’s something to me that always, like, stuck with me,” he said.

In Texas, Copperas Cove High School business education teacher Heather Calhoun recruited students as volunteers for this year’s effort.

“It wasn’t long ago that my children and I had to go to a food bank to get food,” Calhoun told *Killeen Daily Herald*, “so it’s something I thought would be a good way to give back and to help other people out who may be in a hopeless situation.”

That the Postal Service operates America’s only universal delivery network helps to make the job of collecting food easier, Idaho State Association of Letter Carriers President John Paige told KPVI-TV.

“We serve about every residential household in the area,” Paige said, “so we might as well just make it easy and convenient for our customers to leave out food, and make it easy for them to donate.”

Brownsville, TX Branch 1456 Secretary Jesse Nieto said that customers in his area have usually been quite generous, and this year was no exception.

“We’ve always had a good turnout thanks to the residents,” Nieto told *The Brownsville Herald*. “There’s a lot of need out there, and the people are very helpful and contribute a lot.”

Compared with last year, collection figures were up a bit higher in 2015 in Petersburg, VA—a pleasant surprise for Branch 326’s food drive coordinator and secretary Astrid Roney. “I was very impressed by

the people in the community and how they poured out so much love to us this year,” Roney told *The Progress-Index*.

In Duluth, MN, Branch 114 President Scott Dulas has led the food drive effort in his city for the last four years.

“I do love this day,” he told WDIO-TV. “This is my favorite day of the year to be a letter carrier. Not that I don’t enjoy delivering mail, because I do. But this is the one day I feel like I can do more and help the community.”

Sioux City, IA Branch 69’s Bernie Frisch agreed. “I would have to say this is my favorite kind of mail delivery here,” she told KTIV-TV.

Bumps in the road

As any letter carrier can tell you, though, every route has its share of obstacles. Likewise, the path to this year’s food drive had a few rough spots.

A major concern for NALC for 2015 was that by the time preparations for the drive kicked into high gear, no single national sponsor had come forward, as in past years, to cover the cost of our familiar “save the date” food drive postcards.

“These simple notices have for years proved crucial for ensuring that customers remember to put food by their mailboxes,” said NALC Community and Membership Outreach Coordinator Pam Donato, the national coordinator for the food drive. “But letter carriers are a resourceful bunch, so many of us saw this as a chance to expand our search for sponsors, rather than as a setback.”

Fortunately, Donato said, a lot of NALC branches secured financial backing for their own postcard orders from the local chapters of another national sponsor, United Way Worldwide, as well as the locals of other unions. Feeding America

leaned on its network of local food banks for some financial assistance as well.

NALC Headquarters also chipped in to defray some of the costs of printing postcards, especially where the need for them was deemed critical. And more than a few NALC branches themselves gave what they could toward postcard production.

“The success of the NALC is connected to the level of activism and engagement of our local branch leaders and our rank-and-file members who work together to achieve a goal,” Donato said. “It was truly gratifying to see so many letter carriers and local NALC leaders rise up to meet this challenge head on this year.”

In many areas, special food drive bags were again a crucial resource toward the success our annual effort to battle hunger.

“Bags have the powerful effect of doubling, potentially tripling the amount of food collected,” Donato said. “The more bags we collect, the more hungry families we can feed.”

And securing bag sponsorships at the branch and regional levels continued to pay off in major ways.

“The most common sponsors for bags have been grocery stores,” Donato

said, noting the past support from major chains such as Publix and Kroger. But local banks, credit unions and car dealerships often could be called upon to sponsor bags as well.

“The food drive is such an easy sell,” she said. “Bag sponsors understand the value of attaching their names to America’s largest single-day food drive.”

Nationally, union-made paper bags were available through International Paper, while there was a choice of biodegradable, made-in-USA plastic bags from Aurora Plastics and from Bags by CMG.

And once again this year, cartoonist Jeff Keane donated a special “Family Circus” illustration that found its way onto most of these special bags, as well as on banners, billboards and T-shirts promoting the drive.

“It’s great that we can partner with so many other organizations like this,” President Rolando said. “Shining as much bright light as we can on this nagging need within our communities can only help us in our efforts.

“But it still comes down to the efforts of letter carriers,” he said. “Thank you for all of your work, on Food Drive Day as well as in the weeks leading up to it.” **PR**
