Dear Representative,

On behalf of the 295,000 active and retired members of the National Association of Letter Carriers, I write in opposition to S. 1383, the SAVE America Act. This bill would make it harder for U.S. citizens to vote, disproportionately affecting working-class and lower-income citizens. Letter carriers are proud of our work, which allows tens of millions of Americans to participate in our democracy through vote-by-mail, and NALC opposes any effort to suppress voting rights.

Related to our work, S. 1383 includes a dangerous, unnecessary provision that would reject mail-in ballots unless a form of identification is included. This would make an already reliable, preferred and protected process more difficult. Nearly 1 in 3 Americans voted by mail in 2024, and letter carriers safely and securely delivered nearly 100 million ballots to and from voters.

Any insinuation that voting by mail is not safe and secure is severely misguided and inaccurate. The SAVE America Act undermines the validity of mail-in voting while aiming to suppress U.S. citizens' voting rights.

NALC opposes S. 1383 and urges you to vote "no" when it is considered on the House floor.
