COVID-19 vaccine eligibility expanded to everyone over 16

Anyone 16 years of age and older is now eligible for COVID-19 vaccination. The Postal Service encourages all employees who wish to get vaccinated to do so. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), widespread vaccination is a critical tool to help stop the spread of the pandemic.

Effective immediately, every state in the U.S. has opened enrollment to all citizens over the age of 16. To assist people who are interested in receiving a COVID-19 vaccine, the CDC has adopted a new tool.

VaccineFinder is a free service that allows users to search for locations that offer vaccinations and have appointments available. The CDC works with partners such as clinics, pharmacies and health departments to provide accurate and up-to-date information about vaccination services.

The data in VaccineFinder is updated daily and the service is available online at vaccinefinder.org.
