

Branches must order baseball night tickets

Tickets for the special NALC Baseball Night during the 67th Biennial Convention in Anaheim, California, this summer must be ordered by branches in blocks for their delegations. Tickets will not be sold individually, so delegates must contact their local branch leaders to assure their branch purchases sufficient tickets.

The union has reserved 7,000 tickets to the Los Angeles Angels-Kansas City Royals game Tuesday evening, August 10. President Fred Rolando and other NALC officials will participate in a special pre-game ceremony at Angels Stadium.

Tickets are \$10 each, a reduced price that includes bus transportation from NALC convention hotels to the game and back. Branches must order blocks of tickets for delegates and family members using the form in the February 12 *NALC Bulletin*, which includes details of the ordering process.

Seating will be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis, based on the date of receipt of full payment. There are no refunds.

Housing rates finalized

NALC has finalized the housing block and room rates for the convention. A chart with the rates and a map of the area around the Anaheim Convention Center is available on the NALC website, nalc.org. Also available on the site is a document with answers to questions regarding the new automated online housing system for the convention and other topics, including housing deadline dates, changes and cancellations, and group room requests.

Important deadlines

All proposed amendments to the *NALC Constitution* to be submitted to the Anaheim convention must be received by Secretary-Treasurer Jane Broendel at NALC Headquarters by June 10. Proposed amendments will appear in the July *Postal Record* for the entire membership to review.

In order to be printed in the *Resolutions and Amendments* book provided to delegates, resolutions also must be received at Headquarters by June 10. Resolutions received after the deadline may still be considered at the convention.

(Note: Any resolution considered and approved by a previous convention will not be considered at the Anaheim convention unless the motion is to disapprove or rescind a previous action. Also, resolutions and amendments must conform to the form and method of endorsement specified by Articles 12 and 19 of the *Constitution*.)

Branches wishing to sell items in the branch sales area must contact the Secretary-Treasurer's office no later than April 2 to secure sales guidelines and registration forms. The forms must be returned no later than May 7. Only branches that register in advance will be given space in the sales area.

Branches are only permitted to sell items to raise funds for COLCPE and/or the Muscular Dystrophy Association. All products must be 100 percent USA union-made and bear a union label. The only exception is for "craft" items made by NALC members or their families.
