Working together for those in need results in 72.5 million pounds of food

On Saturday, May 10, NALC members taking part in the 22nd annual Letter Carriers' Food Drive joined with rural letter carriers, other postal employees and countless volunteers all across America to collect almost 73 million pounds of food from postal customers to help restock food banks, pantries and shelters around the country.

"Achieving another high-volume figure this year is a testament to the hard work and dedication of everyone who stepped up and got involved," NALC President Fredric Rolando said. "It's truly an impressive result, made all the more necessary by the slow-paced

economic recovery and recent natural disasters."

The drive—the nation's largest single-day food collection effort—gathered 72.5 million pounds of food, the 11th consecutive year the drive has surpassed 70 million pounds. This year's results bring the total to more than 1.3 billion pounds since the national drive began in 1992.

As has become an annual tradition on the second Saturday of May, from major metropolitan areas to small rural communities, residents were asked to put out by their mailboxes bags of non-perishable food donations, which letter carriers collected as they delivered mail along their postal routes. The goods

were then sorted and distributed to local food banks and pantries in more than 10,000 cities and towns in all 50 states as well as U.S. jurisdictions.

"The food drive really demonstrates the value of the unique postal network, which serves 152 million addresses six days a week," Rolando said. "It also shows the strong connection between letter carriers and the communities we serve—a bond that serves the nation well."

Something about Florida

The overall top-collecting NALC branch was the 1,200-member West Coast Florida Branch 1477, whose efforts netted 1,670,688 pounds of food. But it was not the only Florida branch to lead, let alone to crack the million-pound mark.

Sunshine State branches, in fact, were national leaders this year—with Central Florida Branch 1091, Tampa Branch 599 and Clearwater Branch 2008 ringing up totals that cleared a million as well.

Rounding out the national top five was Garden Grove, CA Branch 1100, with 1,158,725 pounds of food collected.

The top-performing branches in each of 11 membership categories (see page 18) received special plaques at the 69th Biennial NALC Convention last month in Philadelphia. The complete list of branch-by-branch totals begins on page 20 of this magazine.

A timely group effort

One of the reasons the food drive is held on the second Saturday of May each year is that, by then, community pantries have become depleted after the typical winter holiday rush of donation generosity. Also, school lunch programs for children in need typically are not available during the summer, making the food drive's timing all the more critical.

"A food drive this big will help fill the summer gap," Susannah Morgan, CEO

of Oregon Food Bank, told the *Northwest Labor Press*. "During the school year, kids have access to free and reduced price meals at school. In the summer, they lose that food source, and many families find themselves needing additional food assistance."

Leah Schilling, a member of the Morrison County, MN Food Shelf's board, concurred. "Summer time is a busy time at the Food Shelf, as school is out and children are home for more meals per day," she said. "This often means more families may need the extra help that the food drive provides."

Hunger affects about 49 million people throughout the country, including millions of senior citizens and children.

"The Postal Service's universal network makes it possible for us to provide this critically needed assistance to the people who need it most," NALC food drive coordinator Pam Donato said. "Also making it possible are the many groups who help us each year."

For example, volunteers from the other postal crafts, assisted by postal managers, help transport the sometimes staggering number of bags of food from LLV to loading dock to food bank. A joint thank-you letter from President Rolando and USPS Postmaster General Patrick Donahoe following the drive's results announcement took special note of how this cooperation

"is one of the great things about the Letter Carriers' Food Drive—it reminds our customers how we always go above and beyond the call of duty."

The food that letter carriers collected

on May 10 was delivered to local food banks, pantries and shelters, many of which are affiliated with Feeding America, a national partner in this year's drive. Also serving as national partners were United Way, AARP Foundations' Drive to End Hunger, the Publix grocery store chain, Campbell Soup Co., the U.S. Postal Service, the National Rural Letter Carriers' Association, the AFL-CIO, Valpak, Valassis and Uncle Bob's Self Storage.

Many local chapters of national volunteer organizations also stepped up to lend valuable assistance on the day of the drive, such as the Salvation Army, Catholic Charities, National Guard units, the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, various student groups,

local Rotary Clubs, local and state AARP groups and local United Way volunteers.

Praise and thanks

Letter carriers certainly see firsthand the needs in the communities where we work, and the countless food banks and pantries that deal with the problem of hunger every single day were quite grateful for our extra effort on the day of the drive.

"These are certainly hard times for so many people," Carol Gilligan, executive director of Pottstown, PA's Coventry Food Pantry, told *The Mercury*. "We truly appreciate your willingness to host this annual food drive and your allowing us to be a recipient of the food collected in our local community."

Martin County, FL's House of Hope made it known in the *Treasure Coast Palm* that its food bank has many groups and individuals to thank for their food drive efforts, "starting with the National Association of Letter Carriers Branch 1690 and the thousands of residents who put food by their mailboxes to contribute to the drive."

Specially designed food drive bags have been a real boost in encouraging postal patrons' generosity in recent years. Many branches that managed to secure bag sponsorship at the local or regional levels reported big jumps in donations compared with previous years.

"Bags are expensive," Donato noted, "and we realize it takes a lot of work for busy letter carriers to secure the backing needed to help defray the cost of ordering bags." Donato noted that some branches had found success in getting local grocery stores to sponsor bags, while other branches found eager sponsor allies at community-minded businesses, such as local financial institutions or car dealerships.

"The food drive on its own generates such a huge amount of goodwill," Ro-





lando said. "Savvy local business-owners pick up on this, realizing that sponsoring bags and attaching their names to their local drive helps us collect more food for those who need it at the same time that it boosts those businesses' standing in their communities."

One such business, Genisys Credit Union in Pontiac, MI, understands how the food drive also gives members of the community an opportunity to help neighbors in need. "This campaign continues to grow each year, and we are proud to support the local NALC branch in their efforts to help make a difference locally," Genisys president and CEO Jackie Buchanan told *The Oakland Press*.

Making a difference

Reports from all over the country tell the story about the difference the food drive makes.

"Through the efforts of our local letter carriers, The BRICK [Believers Reaching Individuals for Christ's Kingdom] Ministries received over 7,800 pounds of food donated by residents in this year's food drive," a BRICK representative told Ashland, WI's *The Daily Press*, which noted that BRICK's food shelf program serves an average of 1,400 people each month, reaching low-income residents of Ashland and Bayfield counties.

"The numbers are in and we received 157,823 pounds of food collected along mail routes in two counties," local United Way Marketing Director Carolyn Folley told *The Destin [FL] Log*. "A special thank you to all letter carriers and the local post offices' personnel for their hard work in this annual food drive. They had to run their normal routes and collect food at the same time."

House of Care Food Pantry's Elizabeth DeLoach also acknowledged the letter carrier effort. "Without your hard work placing bags in mail boxes and picking them up, it would not have been possible to collect the 6,500 pounds of food," she

told the *Thomaston [GA] Times*. "It takes a community working together to meet the needs of those who are in need."

Hawaii Foodbank director of product donations Mike Kajiwara told BigIslandNow.com that the large amount of food collected this year was the result of work, energy and great partnerships. "The NALC food drive brings in much-needed quality food donations during a crucial time of the year," Kajiwara said. "The various agencies we serve have a lot to be thankful for, as we can now provide more valuable nutrition to those in need for months to come."

Reporting more than 80,000 pounds of donated food, Loaves & Fishes Community Services officials told the *Naperville [IL] Sun* that "extra help was needed to sort through a total of 407,610 pounds of food processed," adding that the agency serves more than 12,000 people.

"Thank you to all the letter carriers who worked long hours on Saturday, and who handled and transported heavy bags filled to the brim with food," a coalition of food bank representatives in Newburyport, MA, wrote to the *Daily News*. "We know how much extra work this drive entails, and we are so grateful for your efforts on our behalf."

Down but not out

But with many people still struggling to break free of the effects of the recent recession, a few localities unfortunately reported food donation figures that were lower than in past years.

In one case, Community Food Bank of Southern Arizona CEO Michael McDonald told *Tuscon's The Desert Times* that although an impressive 237,000 pounds of food was collected on May 10, "the results were down from last year's numbers.

"We appreciate the generosity of our communities and the hard work of the National Association of Letter Carriers, staff and community volunteers for all their efforts," McDonald said.

"Although 75,000 [pounds] is slightly down from last year, it still is a huge total," High Point, NC United Way President Bobby Smith told the *Enterprise*.

"I don't see this as a sour note," added High Point United Way's Caroline Jones. "I look at it as, we still have a job to do and we're not going to stop."

Spreading the news

From West Virginia Gov. Earl Ray Tomblin to the Bexar County, TX, commis-

sioners court to Brookhaven, MS, Mayor Joe Cox, quite a few governing bodies and elected officials helped get word out about our annual effort by issuing proclamations declaring May 10 to be an official "Food Drive Day" in their municipalities.

As a show of labor solidarity, a number of the NALC's sister unions also joined the promotional push. For example, the May issue of *The Ironworker*, the monthly





magazine of the national Ironworkers union, carried a full-page ad for the 2014 food drive, featuring the “Family Circus” cartoon.

NALC national food drive coordinator Donato said that all of this upfront promotion of the food drive was critical to the food drive’s success.

“More than 121 million postcards and 30 million bags were delivered to mailboxes all across the country,” she said. “There were full-color posters in English and Spanish, electronic billboards and promotional signs in thousands of businesses—ensuring that drive reminders were seen over and over again, a layered message of hope and action.”

Meanwhile, the NALC website provided a virtual tool kit of resources for branch coordinators, drive partners and the public at large to view and download public service announcement audio and video files, order T-shirts and yard signs, read “how to” guides, and download flyers, forms and artwork—such as Jeff Keane’s customized “Family Circus” cartoon.

Social media also played a larger role than ever before in getting word out about the drive. Dozens of promotional and motivational messages were sent via the Food Drive’s official Twitter and Facebook accounts, reaching more than 100,000 subscribers. An e-mail message went out to the members of the NALC’s e-Activist Network to energize them and to call them to action. And for the first



time, the drive organized a so-called “electronic flash mob” via the Thunderclap service, which ultimately led up to a single reminder message being broadcast across several social media platforms all at the same time on the day before the drive, reaching at least 1.5 million people simultaneously.

The result of all of this outreach, promotion, and hard work? A grand total of 72.5 million pounds of food collected, some of our hungriest customers fed (at least for a while), and awareness raised that hunger continues to be a serious problem in this country despite our position as one of the most prosperous countries on Earth.

And as you might expect, with such a massive undertaking to consider, when one drive ends, preparation for the next one begins almost immediately. That’s why food drive coordinators and branch presidents across America already have started gearing up for what is hoped will be a historic Letter Carriers’ Food Drive on Saturday, May 9, 2015. **PR**
